the study of the international political economy ipe like the ipe itself is plural and unbounded despite what partisans sometimes say rather than there being one way of studying the ipe that is the right way we find across the world great variation in ipe scholarship in terms of focus questions and methods how then can we make sense of this and understand the field as a whole rather than simply learn one part of it this handbook is designed to address precisely this concern it maps the shifting boundaries and diverse theoretical commitments of ipe around the world it engages the geographical and theoretical diversity of the different versions of ipe found in north america the uk in asia and australia and notes the absences of distinctive versions of ipe in europe and latin america the volume groups together the essential attributes and positions of each school inviting the reader to engage with and learn about ipe in all of its guises through this evolving global conversation rather than adjudicate the one true version of ipe it argues that the intellectual diversity we see around the world is an essential and positive feature of the field with over twenty contributors from a wide range of countries routledge handbook of international political economy is an essential resource for all those with an interest in this complex and rapidly evolving field of study

first published in 1998 this volume deals with the explanation of international politics and foreign policy levels of explanation and their interrelationships offer the book s structure based on critiques of major ir approaches a bottom up instead of a systemic top down perspective waltz is advocated but without falling prey to reductionism explaining international politics from domestic factors explanation of state behaviour should primarily stress states salient environment but occasionally also their historical lessons from previous experience with this environment international organizations or other non state actors may be allowed an influence of their own in certain areas but the state remains in ultimate control

no approach to world affairs in the 21st century can afford to ignore the impact that processes of globalisation are having on governments economies cultures and individuals an understanding of the theories that underpin international political economy and their practical applications is therefore crucial to the study of international relations politics development and economics in this comprehensive and accessible introduction to the field the authors consider traditional and alternative approaches to ipe elucidating key concepts assumptions and the intellectual and historical context in which they arose and developed making clear at all times their relevance to issues from trade finance and government to environment technology development and culture the style of this book encourages independent reflection and critical thinking each chapter relates theoretical analysis to contemporary issues by way of giving the student a better understanding of the theory and also demonstrating the value of theory in the real world

this exciting new textbook challenges the implicit notions inherent in most existing international relations ir scholarship and instead presents the subject as seen from different vantage points in the global south divided into four sections 1 the ir discipline 2 key concepts and categories 3 global issues and 4 ir futures it examines the ways in which world politics have been addressed by traditional core approaches and explores the limitations of these treatments for understanding both southern and northern experiences of the international the book encourages readers to consider how key ideas have been developed in the discipline and through systematic interventions by contributors from around the globe aims at both transforming and enriching the dominant terms of scholarly debate this empowering critical and reflexive tool for thinking about

the diversity of experiences of international relations and for placing them front and center in the classroom will help professors and students in both the global north and the global south envision the world differently in addition to general introductory ir courses at both the undergraduate and graduate levels it will appeal to courses on sociology and historiography of knowledge globalization neoliberalism security the state imperialism and international political economy
